Baptist Bible Seminary in Johnson City, New York

We are deeply conscious that the future of historic Baptist testimony so far as the pulpit ministry is concerned, depends largely upon men trained not only in a knowledge of the English Bible but also equipped with a Baptist consciousness, which will make them capable leaders of Baptist churches.

We are devoutly thankful to God for the Bible institutes of our land which have been raised up to provide training for young men and women desirous of entering into full time ministry of the Word, but because of the very nature of these institutions, they cannot present a curriculum which includes denominational coloring. The situation among Baptists today demands more than ever not only Bible trained ministry but a Baptistically trained ministry.

We are therefore grateful to God for the raising up of the Johnson City Baptist Bible Seminary. After visiting the home of the seminary and witnessing its demonstration on this platform during the sessions of this conference, we wish to go on record as commending the seminary to our Baptist youth who desire not only a Bible institute training but a seminary training as well. We strongly urge our Baptist young men and women to give earnest consideration to the Johnson City Baptist Seminary, and we trust that scores of them will turn their steps in this direction.
