

Conservative Movement in the Northern Baptist Convention

RESOLVED, that the Council of Fourteen of the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches–North, heartily concur in the spirit of friendliness expressed in the letter of Dr. R. T. Ketcham, written to Drs. Neal and Johnson under date of March 10, 1945; and that this Council wishes it to be known, that in the event of the separation of these brethren and those associated with them from the Northern Baptist Convention, that without seeking to intrude ourselves, we earnestly desire opportunity to discuss with them the possibility of uniting our forces in a great testimony and witness to the historic Baptist faith, based upon the verbally inspired Word of God.
