Separation Reaffirmed

The Constitution and spirit of the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches calls for and demands that any church desiring the fellowship shall be completely separated from any and all apostate organizations. Therefore, while recognizing the right of a Baptist church to fellowship with whom it pleases, we deem it a distinct violation of both the Constitution and spirit of the GARBC for any church in our Fellowship to unite itself with any organization, which permits within its membership churches still in apostate organizations.
