Proposal for Incorporation

WHEREAS the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches as presently constituted has no legal status which would qualify it for the receiving of legacies or the ownership of property; and

WHEREAS in the providence of God, our Association has grown to the point where both of these privileges are, or may be, highly desirable;

THEREFORE it is the unanimous recommendation of the Council of Fourteen that the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches take the necessary steps toward incorporation.
