The United Nations Organization

Remembering the word of the Psalmist that "Blessed is that nation whose God is Jehovah "and that "Except the Lord build the house they labor in vain who build it," we of the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches meeting in the 23rd annual session in Chicago, Illinois, May 10–13, 1954, call upon the government of the United States to immediately withdraw from the United Nations Organization.

From its inception it has been doomed as an instrument of world peace because of deliberately refusing to recognize the God of the Holy Scriptures in its assembly and counsels. Declining such recognition of God lest it incur the displeasure of atheistic ad Communistic Russia, the UNO has degenerated into an impotent agency of peace and has become a mere sounding board for the Communistic propaganda of atheistic Russia, the One-Worldism of American left-wingers whose purpose is to sell out the sovereignty of the United states for a mess of international pottage as exemplified in the proposed Genocide Convention Treaty, and for UNESCO, the UNO's educational arm, which is using its influence in the schools of America to undermine our tradition system of education which has always been the handmaid of our free-enterprise system with its emphasis upon the dignity of the individual and the freedoms of assembly, speech, press, and worship.

FURTHERMORE the UNO has been a destructive force in America through its tremendous cost in money and men at home and in prestige and position abroad.

Having in the UNO therefore, the seeds of our own national dissolution economically, educationally, socially, and spiritually, through its potential for the Scripturally predicted world-government of the Anti-Christ, we call upon all true Christians, as well as all true Americans of whatever color or creed, to write their congressmen in favor of this resolution.
