

VOH Intern Specifics

Responsibilities:

- 24 hours of Resident Assistant Supervisory work during three static 8 hour shifts / week
- Real time crisis counseling as needed while on duty
- Attendance at Staff meeting Wednesdays from 12:30—3 pm

Benefits:

- Interns receive free housing, free meals, and free access to laundry facilities for the duration of their stay.
- Interns may use their free time to complete college classes locally or online, participate in Faith Biblical Counseling Ministries trainings (on own time and at own expense), or work part—time off-site.

Requirements:

- The standard time period for interns is one year, although other arrangements will be considered.
- Interns must attend Faith Baptist Church during their internship.
- If college credits are desired for the internship, advance notice must be given and appropriate arrangements made.
