

The Effects of Modern Religious Unbelief

WHEREAS this emphasis is particularly noticeable within the ranks of the National Council of Churches and other ecumenical movements; and

WHEREAS this "false gospel" has contributed significantly to the rise of lawlessness and the decay of morality in our nation;

BE IT RESOLVED that we, the messengers of the churches in fellowship with the General Association of Regular Baptist Churches, meeting in annual session in Denver, Colorado, June 22–26, 1970, reaffirm our conviction in the power of the gospel of saving grace as found in the New Testament; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we strongly declare that the Bible sets forth the fixed moral standards established by God and that these standards should be proclaimed and obeyed, particularly by those who claim to be religious leaders.
