Wickedness and Danger of NCC and WCC

WHEREAS recent criticism and exposure of the National Council of Churches and the World Council of Churches has surfaced through the public media since the documentary television broadcast of CBS 60 Minutes and the article "Do You Know Where Your Church Offerings Go?" in the January, 1983 Readers Digest, and the article "The Winds of War" in the May-June, 1983 Saturday Evening Post; and

WHEREAS for many years the GARBC has exposed the NCC and WCC for its apostasy from Bible Doctrine; and

WHEREAS the American Council of Christian Churches has carefully documented and reported many of the anti-American policies and socialistic, pro-communist causes which the NCC and the WCC have advocated and often instigated; and

WHEREAS the World Council of Churches is meeting in Vancouver, Canada, this July 24–August 7, which no doubt, will advance the apostasy of the ecumenical movement and the cause of Satan; and

WHEREAS the NCC on May 13, 1983, has endorsed the pastoral letter of the Roman Catholic bishops which not only condemns any first use of nuclear weapons and demands a halt to more production, and even goes so far as to rule out their use even in retaliation of a nuclear attack; further it is calling for a "new theology of peace. . .which views nuclear war as a most sinful confrontation with our Creator" which is not only illogical, but blasphemous;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the messengers of the GARBC meeting in Niagara Falls on June 27–July 1, 1983, warn the American public of the spiritual wickedness and the political deviousness of the NCC and the WCC; and

FURTHER we urge all freedom loving Americans who belong to any of the 32 church denominations in the NCC to cease financial support and leave this apostate organization.
